Intended Purpose	An endoscopic instrument intended to be used to perform through a compatible endoscope. It is used to obtain specimens for histological/pathological diagnosis during endoscopy. It is typically constructed of a rigid metal tube whose distal end is equipped with a pair of cups which is operated by a control handle attached at the proximal end of the instrument. It is introduced into the body cavity through an artificial orifice of the body or the working channel of the endoscope.
